1 INTRODUCTION

This Cookies Policy explains how BPIF Training Ltd (“we”, “our”, or “us”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website.

By continuing to use our website, you can manage your cookie preferences through our cookie consent banner and settings tool.

2 WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience, remember preferences, and provide information about how visitors use the site.

Cookies may be:

- ◆ Session cookies – deleted when you close your browser.
- ◆ Persistent cookies – remain on your device until they expire or are deleted.
- ◆ First-party cookies – set by our website.
- ◆ Third-party cookies – set by external service providers.

3 HOW WE USE COOKIES

We use cookies for the following purposes:

STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

These cookies are essential for the operation of our website and cannot be switched off in our systems.

Examples include cookies that:

- ◆ Remember cookie consent preferences
- ◆ Enable website security functions
- ◆ Support website navigation
- ◆ Maintain session information

PERFORMANCE AND ANALYTICS COOKIES

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website so that we can improve its performance and functionality.

They may collect information such as:

- ◆ Pages visited
- ◆ Time spent on pages
- ◆ Traffic sources
- ◆ Error messages encountered

Where used, analytics cookies only collect information in an aggregated and anonymised form where possible.

FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make, such as:

- ◆ Form completion preferences
- ◆ User settings
- ◆ Language preferences
- ◆ Other personalised features

MARKETING AND THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Where applicable, third-party services embedded within our website may set cookies.

These services may include:

- ◆ Social media platforms
- ◆ Video hosting providers such as YouTube or Vimeo
- ◆ Marketing and email subscription services
- ◆ Embedded content from third-party websites

These providers may collect information about your interaction with embedded content.

4 COOKIES WE MAY USE

The exact cookies used may change as our website develops. Categories may include:

COOKIE TYPE	PURPOSE
Necessary	Website functionality and security
Analytics	Understanding website usage and performance
Functional	Remembering user preferences
Marketing	Measuring campaign effectiveness and user engagement

5 YOUR CONSENT AND OUR LEGAL BASIS

Our use of cookies is governed by the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (PECR) and, where cookies collect personal data, by the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Strictly necessary cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are set without consent. This is permitted under the exemption in Regulation 6(4) of PECR, which applies to storage or access that is essential to provide the service you have asked for. These cookies cannot be disabled through our settings tool.

All other cookies

Analytics, functionality and marketing cookies are non-essential. We only set these where you have given your consent through our cookie consent banner. They are not placed on your device before you consent.

Consent must meet the standard set by the UK GDPR, which means it must be freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous. Accordingly:

- ◆ We do not use pre-ticked boxes or sliders set to “on” by default.
- ◆ We do not treat continued use of the website as consent.
- ◆ Rejecting non-essential cookies is as straightforward as accepting them.
- ◆ We ask for consent by category, so you can accept some types and refuse others.

You can withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawing consent is as easy as giving it, and will not affect your ability to use the website.

We keep a record of the consent you give so that we can demonstrate compliance, and we will ask you to confirm your preferences again periodically.

6 MANAGING COOKIES

You can manage or withdraw your consent at any time through our cookie settings tool.

7 THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

- ◆ WP Forms

These third parties are responsible for the cookies they set and for their own privacy practices. We recommend reviewing their privacy and cookie policies.

8 DATA PROTECTION AND YOUR RIGHTS

Where cookies collect information that identifies you, or could identify you when combined with other information, that information is personal data. We process it in accordance with our Privacy Notice, and our lawful basis for doing so is your consent.

Under the UK GDPR you have the right to access the personal data we hold about you, to have it corrected or erased, to restrict or object to its processing, and to receive it in a portable format. To exercise any of these rights, contact us using the details in section 10.

You also have the right to complain to the Information Commissioner's Office, the UK supervisory authority for data protection and PECR. You can contact the ICO at ico.org.uk or on 0303 123 1113. We would appreciate the chance to address your concerns before you approach the ICO.
